
JOSHUA 6:1-21

Joshua and the Israelites were in Canaan. The Israelites gathered near the city of Jericho. Jericho was a strong city with a large strong wall. The gates were closed.

God told Joshua what to do.

He told Joshua to march around the city one time each day for six days. On the seventh day, the people

were to march around the city seven times. Then they must shout. God would help the people capture the city.



On the seventh day, they marched around the city seven times. After the seventh time, the priests blew their trumpets. Joshua said, "Shout!" The Israelites shouted.

The walls fell down and the Israelites captured the city.
