

# The Early Church Chose Helpers

#### ACTS 6:1-7

One day a group of people came to talk to the disciples (Jesus' helpers). The people were not happy. They said that some people were not getting the help they needed from the church. The disciples called a special meeting of the church to talk about the problem.



The disciples knew that everyone in the church had an important job to do to serve God's people and help spread the good news about Jesus. So the disciples asked the church members to choose seven men who loved the Lord to help take care of the people who needed food and other things.

The church chose seven men who had good reputations and were full of the Spirit and wisdom. The first church helpers were Stephen, Phillip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolaus. The seven helpers went to the front of the church and stood before the disciples. The disciples laid hands on them and prayed. The helpers got to work, taking care of people in need, just like helpers in our church do today.
