



Jesus' Special Supper

#### MATTHEW 26:17-19,26-30; 1 CORINTHIANS 11:17-29

It was the first day of Passover. Passover is a holiday celebrated by Jewish people. Certain types of bread and other foods are eaten at the Passover meal. Jesus' disciples came to Him that day and asked where to prepare for that night's special meal.



Jesus said that they should go to a certain man in the city and tell him that they would celebrate Passover at his house that night. Then the disciples began preparing the meal at the man's house.

That evening, Jesus and the disciples ate the special Passover meal together. Jesus took some bread. He thanked God for it. Jesus gave some of the bread to each of the disciples and told them to eat it.

Jesus took a cup, gave thanks for it, and told His disciples to drink from the cup. When everyone had eaten the bread and taken a drink from the cup, Jesus told them, "Do this to remember Me."

When supper was over, Jesus and His disciples sang songs together. Then they went out to the Mount of Olives.

After Jesus died on the cross, came back to life, and went to heaven, people in the church ate bread and drank from a cup to remember Jesus and what He did for us, just as He said to do.
