Family Discussion

- Repent means to turn away from your sin and turn to Jesus. Explain a "U-Turn." This is a simple way to illustrate repentance. You are going one direction but without stopping you turn and go the opposite direction now.
- Discuss why baptism follows salvation.
- We receive the gift of the Holy Spirit when we are saved. Discuss how the Holy Spirit works in and around our life.
- Why is it important to choose "Your One" person that you are praying for and seeking to share how Jesus forgives their sin?

Family Action

Each family member that has accepted Jesus for the forgiveness of their sin should tell their story and include the story of their baptism.

Optional Idea: If your children are in elementary school or older, discuss the Trinity of God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit). Illustration: water (H_2O) as ice, liquid, and steam but they are the same thing (H_2O) just in different expressions.
