

Frequently Asked Questions

We are super pumped that you will be joining us February 22-23, 2019 for B.I.G. Weekend! This page is to be a resource for you as you promote this weekend to your students. We have also listed a section of basic Q&A that we hope will serve you as you prepare for the weekend.

When is the event?

February 22-23, 2019

What is the theme of the weekend?

This year the theme of B.I.G. Weekend is **Renew**. Over the weekend, we are going to look at the life of one of Jesus' twelve disciples, Peter. We will witness the renewal of Peter's own life as we follow the narrative of his discipleship with Christ, his encounter with the risen Christ, and his ministry of the gospel after the ascension of Christ.

Is this a conference or a Disciple Now?

Yes. This weekend could serve as a platform for you to host a Disciple Now if that would serve your church and students best. This weekend could also serve as a weekend conference for your students.

Where can we stay?

If you are coming from out of town and need overnight accommodations we have hotel suggestions below. Hotels/AirBNB

Are meals provided?

No. You are responsible for providing food for your students.

Will students need money at the event?

Yes, but not necessary. Some of the on stage personalities may have merchandise available before and after main sessions.

What does the \$30 per student registration fee cover?

The fee covers programming cost, booklets for students, and downloadable files for your own promotional purposes leading up to the event.

Does the \$30 fee apply to adults as well?

No. There is no charge for church staff members or adult volunteers.

Do students get t-shirts?

No, we will not provide shirts. However, as part of the registration fee you will have access to graphics that can be used for you to print your own shirts for your students.

What are the payment options to register our group?

The online registration that is set is for those who can by credit card.

What if more/fewer students come than we registered for?

We can make adjustments within reason (plus or minus 5-10). For example: If you register 20 and only bring 15 we can make those adjustments with ease.

Who is hosting the main sessions?

Quail Springs Baptist Church (14613 N. May Avenue Oklahoma City, OK 73134)

Where should we park at QSBC?

All participants are encouraged to park in the West Parking Lot, North Parking Lot, or Northeast Parking Lot.

Where do we enter once we arrive at QSBC?

All participants, leaders, and adults will need to enter the doors located under the Archway (big white arches). You can enter from the East and West side of the property.

What time will doors open at QSBC?

The external doors will open 30 minutes prior to main sessions beginning. The only exception is the first night when doors will open up 45 minutes prior to main session.

Does QSBC allow food and drinks in the worship center?

No food or drinks are allowed in the worship center except for water.

Is there assigned seating in the worship center at QSBC?

The seating will be first come first serve for groups. We do encourage student ministries to sit together. If not we ask that your students are at least sitting with their small group and small group leader.
