



2019 Intentional Friends Ministry

Purpose: Reaching a woman right where she is to help her become the woman God designed her to be.

What is the Intentional Friends Ministry?

- It is a ministry for women of all ages based on Titus 2:3-5.
- Women invest in the lives of each other through encouragement, guidance, listening, laughing and loving.
- The goal is to form strong and lasting relationships among women of different generations that are a source of support, growth and strength.

What is an "Older Friend" and what do they do?

- A woman who is trusting God as she navigates the seasons and experiences of life.
- She is a mature woman who is developing in faith and consistent in godly conduct.
- She is willing to listen, share skills, and provide a biblical perspective for life experiences.
- She provides wisdom and offers spiritually sound advice in a safe and fun friendship to a younger woman.
- One leads simply because she knows the path a little better.

What is a "Younger Friend" and what do they do?

- A younger friend is a woman who welcomes the insight and knowledge of a more mature woman.
- She desires to develop certain skills and/or strengths for her personal, spiritual journey.
- She is looking for a woman who has dealt with or understands the struggles she now faces.
- She desires to grow, is teachable and is willing to ask for help.
- She needs a woman that has lived life longer than her, that is willing to have a transparent relationship by sharing what God has taught her in life.

Why have an Intentional Friends Ministry?

- God commands us to raise up the next generation: Matthew 28:19-20; 2 Timothy 2:2
- Teaching what we've learned is the Lord's plan for growth and maturity: Titus 2:1,3-5
- Spiritual friendships from different generations are extremely valuable in a woman's life: Proverbs 27:9, 17

What commitment does the Intentional Friends Ministry require?

- Your commitment is from March 31, 2019 to December 31, 2019.
- You agree to make contact once a week, by email, calls, card, etc.
- You agree to meet at least once a month...for coffee, lunch, visit, shopping, consider doing/taking a bible study together. Every relationship with be unique.
- You agree to pray for each other regularly.

What are the important Intentional Friends dates and deadlines?

- Your profile sheets are due on March 8, 2019.
- Submitting your profile sheet enrolls you in the Intentional Friends Ministry.
- Attend the "Meet Me for Coffee" event on Sunday March 31, 2019 at 10:40a-11:00a in Fellowship Hall. This will be the beginning of your Intentional Friends relationship.

How will I be "matched" with my partner?

STEP 1: Complete the profile sheet and turn it in to QSBC Ministry office by March 8th

STEP 2: Your profile sheet will be reviewed, prayed over and matched.

STEP 3: Attend "Meet Me for Coffee," Sunday, March 31, 2019 at 10:40a in Fellowship Hall to meet your Intentional Friends partner.

Can I choose my Intentional Friend or keep my friend from last year?

- You may make a recommendation, which will be considered and prayed over as we seek God's choice for each woman who participates in this ministry.

What do I do if "my match" is not working out?

- Please don't just walk away from the relationship.
- Pray - Be sure you have given the relationship reasonable opportunity to connect and develop into a friendship.
