Character Contract for Student Participation at Welcome Weekend 2020

The following is a contract that all students & parents must read, understand, agree to, and sign before participating in this summer's 2020 Welcome Weekend. In addition to the student's signature, a parent or guardian must also read and sign the contract. By signing this contract each student is obliged to comply by the guidelines set forth by QSBC Student Ministry, Dylan Bone and sponsors or will deal with the consequences assigned. The purpose for this contract is twofold. First, it provides a structure base or known expectations and secondly, it allows us as a Welcome Weekend community to move beyond behavioral issues to focusing on the message of Jesus Christ.

I (print first and last name) ________, do agree to follow the guidelines listed below, and in doing so make a commitment of character to the church, my family, my peers, and myself.

- 1. I will be respectful of myself, other students at camp, the sponsors, and the campground. I will be sensitive, caring, and aware of other's needs, and respect their space and wishes.
- 2. I will be accepting of all other individuals even if they are different than me.
- 3. I will take responsibility for my own actions and learn from my mistakes so as not to repeat them unnecessarily.
- 4. I will not participate in, encourage, promote, or condone, in any manner illegal (fireworks, alcohol, drugs, vandalism, vaping), unethical, or potentially harmful activities to myself or the campground.
- 5. I understand physical or verbal abuse towards other campers will not be tolerated period.
- 6. I understand that I will, in no way, be alone and out of sight with someone of the opposite sex.
- 7. I understand that proper attire is important and may be different for different situations. I will follow the guidelines for Welcome Weekend. No tank-tops, sleeveless shirts (exception: girls may wear tops with shoulders being at least three fingers wide!), and with the exception being ladies swimsuits. Acceptable swimwear for women is a one-piece Acceptable for the men are trunks, no Speedo's! I will wear a mask when I am required to.
- 8. I understand that while I am at camp the sponsors, youth leaders, and camp staff have my best interest in mind, and I will abide by what they say beginning with the trip to camp through my return.
- 9. I will follow the schedule for the week doing my best to be where I am supposed to be when I am supposed to be there. I will also participate in all events that are scheduled for me.
- 10. I will keep my belongings in order and respect others by keeping my bunk area clean.
- 11. I understand the reason for camp is to focus on Jesus Christ, therefore I will leave all my electronic devices at home. I will check my cell phone in when instructed to at Welcome Weekend and will only use it in the designated time it is allowed.
- 12. I will have fun, but not at someone else's expense; this includes pranks.
- 13. Knowing that the purpose for this camp is to provide teachings about Jesus Christ, I will commit to being open to God's leading in my life this week.
- 14. As a middle school student, I understand that I am required to be in a group of at least three as I move about the campgrounds. I will not enter another cabin for any reason that is not affiliated with QSBC. This is for my protection as well as my accountability during the week.

If I do not abide by these guidelines that I have committed to, I understand the consequences that follow: I will be
confronted about my actions and/or I will be given an appropriate type of discipline and/or I will be sent home (at my
parents' expense). I will also be financially responsible for any damage other than accidental damage.
