




CONVERSATION

People Praise Jesus

LUKE 19:28-40; JOHN 12:12-18

It was time for the Jewish celebration of Passover. *Passover* is a holiday celebrated by Jewish people. The Passover festival was taking place in Jerusalem. Jesus told two of the disciples (helpers) to go to a nearby village. He said, "You will find a young donkey tied there. Bring it to Me."



Along the way, a crowd of people were waiting to see Jesus. Some took palm branches and went out to meet Him. Some people spread their coats on the road before Jesus. The whole crowd joyfully praised God. "Hosanna!" they cried. "Hosanna!"

Some church leaders were angry that the people were so excited to welcome Jesus. They told Jesus to quiet His disciples down. But Jesus did not. The people continued to praise Jesus.
