God Gave the Commandments

EXODUS 19–20; 31:18

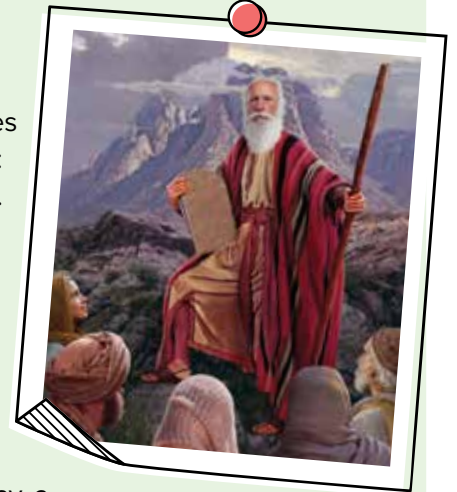
Moses led God's people out of Egypt. They camped beside a mountain. Moses went up the mountain. God told Moses: "Remind the people that I helped them. Tell them I want them to obey Me. I am coming in a cloud to speak to you. The people will see the cloud and hear Me. Tell them to wash their clothes and not to touch the mountain."

Moses told the people what God had said. They replied: "We will do what God tells us to do." On the third day, a thick cloud appeared, thunder rang, and a loud trumpet sounded.

Moses went up the mountain to talk to God. God told Moses and the people to obey these ten special rules, or Commandments.

- Do not worship anyone but God. God is the only God.
- Do not worship anything you have made.
- Always say God's name in a respectful way.
- Work on six days. On the seventh day, rest and worship God.
- Honor and respect your father and mother.
- Do not kill anyone.
- Husbands and wives should keep their wedding promises to each other.
- Do not take something that belongs to someone else.
- Do not tell lies about other people. Always tell the truth.
- Do not wish for things that belong to other people.

Later, God gave Moses two stone tablets with the Commandments.
