

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

Scripture

Luke 24:17-27,30-35

Session Summary

As Jesus walked with the men on the road, He revealed to them how they should interpret the Old Testament. Through the Holy Spirit illuminating Scripture, we, like the early disciples, are enabled to read all of Scripture in light of Jesus' life, death, resurrection, and ascension—the good news that God is working to make all things new, a plan that had been in place since before the foundations of the world. Imagine the men's surprise when they discovered that the One whose explanation of Scripture set their hearts ablaze turned out to be their risen King!

Conversation Questions

- How should we rely upon the Holy Spirit when we read Scripture?
- Why is it important to read Scripture through the lens of the gospel?
- What are some ways we can be intentional about reading Scripture together as a family this week?
- How can we make sure our hearts are set ablaze for Christ on a daily basis?

Family Challenge

Choose a book of the Bible that your family can read together over the next few weeks. Pick a time of the day that works best (first thing in the morning, right after dinner, etc.) and commit to reading together daily until you finish that book of the Bible. Allow each member of the family to take turns reading and make sure to pray beforehand to ask for the help of the Holy Spirit to illuminate God's Word clearly.
