The Preschool and Children's Ministry is often a families first touch at Quail Springs Baptist Church. Our goal is to provide foundational Biblical teaching in an age appropriate way in everything we do.

Sunday Morning Leader

To help provide foundational Biblical teaching each week to our babies thru 5th grade, during either the 9:30 or 11:00 hours. Curriculum, resources and teacher helps are provided. Volunteers can serve on a weekly basis, a monthly rotation or as a sub when needed.

Wednesday Evening Leader

- To help with our Quail Kids (elementary) to provide Biblical teaching thru Bible skills and scripture memory. Volunteers can serve as coaches or classroom leaders (curriculum and resources are provided) on a weekly basis or as a substitute when needed.
- To help with our Mission Friends (preschool) to provide Biblical teaching and mission education. Volunteers can serve as classroom leaders or helpers (curriculum and resources are provided) on a weekly basis or as a substitute when needed.

Greeters

To greet new families and visitors as they arrive, helping them to find the correct classrooms for their preschoolers or children, the worship service and/or a Connect Group for parents. This would be on a weekly basis for a short time at the start of the 9:30 and 11:00 a.m. services.

Volunteers

To help with occasional copying and sorting of quarterly curriculum, organizing and restocking our Resource Rooms, and preparing items for special events.

Connect Group Leader

The role of a Connect Group leader is to invest, encourage, teach, and challenge students weekly as they lead them in a weekly study of God's Word. The Connect Group Leader will work amongst a team as they teach a specific grade/gender.

Connect Group Director

The Connect Group Director will help out each week as they collect attendance, input attendance, and help in the operation and running of Sunday morning Connect Groups. The Director will help with follow up and greeting new students and families as well on Sunday mornings.

Midweek Small Group Leader

Small group leaders will invest into students during Midweek Worship by leading a small group that will go over discussion questions, made by the staff, from the sermon that evening. They will connect with students as a weekly connection point and encourage them in their walk with Jesus.

Midweek FIT Team

The First Impressions Team serves in our café, greets students at the door, assists with check-in, and helps connect guests to our student ministry.

Midweek Tech/Worship

These positions are designed to help facilitate our Midweek worship service by helping out with our tech team which includes running our sound board, lights, podcast. There is also the opportunity to help out with the worship team by helping lead and encourage students in leading worship.

Discipleship Group Leader

Discipleship Group Leaders will help lead a weekly discipleship group that consists of going over daily readings in the Bible, accountability questions, prayer, and Scripture memory. This leader will help students dive deeper into their faith and help them walk more faithfully in their relationship with Jesus.

Falls Creek Sponsor

A Falls Creek Sponsor comes with the student ministry to camp! There are roles from helping cook food, lead small groups, taking photos/video, etc.

BIG WKND Help

A sponsor at BIG WKND ranges from host homes (host students in your home during the weekend), co-hosts (help out with a host home with food/transporting students), and check in.

Servant Leader

Coordinate with the Student Assistant for behind the scenes tasks such as registration for events, preparing forms/packets, preparation for trips/events, etc. This is primarily an event driven role.

Teacher/Substitute Teacher

Director

Care Group Leader

The role of the Connect Group Social Planner is to organize and plan social gatherings where community can be deepened among members.

Group Record Keeper

The role of the Connect Group Record Keeper is to maintain the group, take weekly attendance, and communicate with Director and Teachers.

Physicians, PAs, NPs, RNs, LPNs, EMTs, Paramedics

The clinic is a wholistic ministry that seeks to meet physical and spiritual needs of patients who have no insurance. Healthcare providers and other professionals serve on a rotating basis on Thursdays from 6:00-9:00 p.m.

Spiritual Care Team Member

The clinic is a wholistic ministry, and so every patient who comes in meets with a spiritual care team member in addition to seeing a healthcare provider. This team seeks to share Jesus with patients, to pray with them, to point them to spiritual resources, and to listen when they need to talk.

Translators

We need people who can provide spiritual care in a second language and who can translate for patients as they receive healthcare. We primarily need Spanish speakers, but we also need other language speakers to serve as an interpreter over the phone.

Registration Desk Attendant

Registration desk attendants warmly welcome and check in patients when they arrive. They give patients forms to fill out and create folders of information on patients.

Guest Parking Team Member

The church has spots reserved for guests, and the guest parking team mans those spots before the 9:30 and 11:00 a.m. services to greet visitors and to give them directions. Volunteers serve once every four weeks.

Door Greeter Team Member

Door greeters serve monthly by standing at key church entrances to greet everyone and to direct guests to a Welcome Center or Worship venue. The primary goal is to provide a warm, smooth experience for first-time guests.

Welcome Center Team Member

These volunteers give guests information about Connect Groups and Worship Services, and help get them to where they wish to go. The primary goal is to provide a warm, smooth experience for first-time guests.

Assist Parking Team Member

This team provides valet parking for elderly and impaired church members and visitors. It is an immense blessing to those who use this service.

Traffic Team Member

Safety is an issue at noon when the 11 a.m. service and Connect Groups get out and cars start trying to exit onto May Ave. This team directs traffic at one or two locations to maintain flow and to protect pedestrians as they cross driveways. Team members serve once a month for 30-45 minutes.
