



God helps me love others, both friends and enemies.





Jesus Loved Zacchaeus

LUKE 19:1-10

Jesus came to the town of Jericho. Zacchaeus was in Jericho. Zacchaeus was a tax collector. During this time, tax collectors often charged people more taxes than they owed and kept the extra for themselves. The people did not like tax collectors because they took so much money and made themselves rich.

Zacchaeus wanted to see who Jesus was, but he couldn't. He was a short man, and he could not see



over the crowd. He ran ahead of the crowd and climbed up a sycamore tree so he could watch Jesus pass by and see over the crowds.

Imagine Zacchaeus' surprise when Jesus stopped at the very tree where Zacchaeus was! Jesus stopped and looked up. He said, "Zacchaeus, hurry down! I need to stay at your house today."

Zacchaeus must have been surprised at Jesus' kind words to a tax collector. He quickly came down and welcomed Jesus. People in the crowd complained, saying, "Jesus is going to stay with a sinful man!"

Zacchaeus said to Jesus, "I will give half of everything I own to the poor. If I have taken money unfairly from anyone, I will pay back four times as much!"

Jesus said, "Salvation has come here today. I have come to look for and to save people who are without God."
