

## CONVERSATION

# Paul Wrote About the Lord's Supper

#### MATTHEW 26:17-30; 1 CORINTHIANS 11:17-29

It was time for the celebration of Passover. *Passover* is the feast to remind Israel of how God delivered them from slavery in Egypt. The disciples were asking Jesus where they should celebrate and have their Passover meal.



Jesus gave the disciples very specific instructions. He said to go into the city to a certain man and tell him, "The Teacher says My time is near; I am celebrating the Passover at your place with My disciples." The disciples did what Jesus asked, and that evening they were at a table together having their Passover meal.

Jesus knew one of the disciples at the meal with Him would betray Him.

As they were eating, Jesus took some bread in His hand, blessed it, and broke it into pieces. Jesus told them to remember Him as they ate it. After they ate the bread, Jesus took a cup and gave thanks. He said it was a sign of His promise to all who believed in Him. Jesus would die on the cross for the forgiveness of sins, so everyone who believes in Him would be saved. After they finished their Passover meal, the group sang a hymn together before they left to go to the Mount of Olives.

Paul reminded Christians in the Book of 1 Corinthians that it is important for believers to gather together to participate in the Lord's Supper. It is important for the church to remember how Jesus died on the cross by observing the Lord's Supper. Christians participate in the Lord's Supper to proclaim Jesus' sacrifice on the cross as Savior.
