LUKE 3:1-22

The word of God came to John while he was living in the wilderness. He began to travel around telling the message he had received from God. John's message from God was a call to repent, which means to turn or change from disobeying God to obeying Him.

John reminded the people of a



promise in the Book of Isaiah. God would send a Messiah who would do things that were too difficult for people, and He would bring salvation to all mankind. John wanted everyone to be ready for this Messiah, who is Jesus.

The people listening began to wonder if John might be the Messiah. John answered them: "I baptize you with water, but one who is more powerful than I is coming."

John preached to the people, and all who believed were baptized. Jesus was also baptized to set an example. And while Jesus was praying, heaven opened and the Holy Spirit came down on Him in a physical appearance like a dove. A voice came from heaven saying, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well-pleased."
